Contributions Committee December 15, 2019 Deadline Submission

As you might imagine, each year our Club receives numerous requests for funding. Our 2019-2020 Contributions Committee has established procedures and guidelines to review such requests. It is truly a team effort to reach out to those worthy non-profits. We are asking all Club members to help us in our outreach and provide the donation request forms to their favorite non-profits.

If you would like a "Donation Request" form, please reach out Sandra Knudson or myself. Every organization must complete a request, if they would like to be considered for funds from our Club. We are seeking to fund specific program needs not administrative costs. Supporting documents are encouraged, but not in lieu of completing the forms. Incomplete forms or lack of supporting documents will not be considered.

The request for funds should be no greater than \$5,000.00 and only one submission per non-profit organization. <u>Our deadline for submission received at P.O. Box 5012, Fresno, CA 93755 is no later than December 15, 2019</u>. Be sure to add on the outside envelope "Attention Contributions Committee."

After the New Year, the Committee will begin the lengthy review process and finalize their selections. The Committee may contact the top most deserving organizations for a one-on-one interview. In late March 2020, we will notify those organizations by email if they will not be granted their request.

In April 2020, after the review process, we will provide our recommendation to our membership for those organizations who will be recipients of our donation. Checks will be disbursed in May 2020.

Thank you to all of our members who are spreading the word to nonprofits to submit their donation requests.
