FEDERATION HISTORY ... NOBEL PRIZE WINNER!

Did you know that a General Federation of Women's Club member was the first woman to be awarded the Nobel Peace prize? Jane Adams won the Nobel Peace Prize in 1931. In 1889 she co-founded (with Ellen Gates Star) Hull House, the first settlement house in the United States. Hull House, located in Chicago, was influenced by Toyenbee Hall in the East end of London. Settlement houses like Hull House were a type of welfare house for the neighborhood poor and a center for social reform. Hull House became a National Historic Landmark in 1966.




